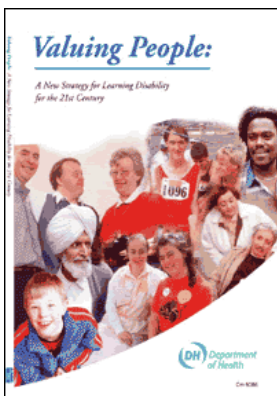

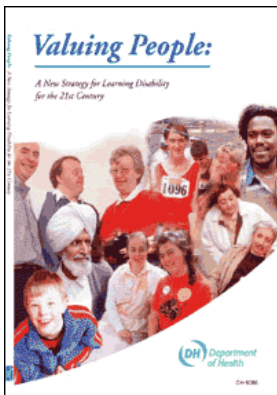

- Programmes are not meant to last for ever, local areas can keep implementing Valuing People principles



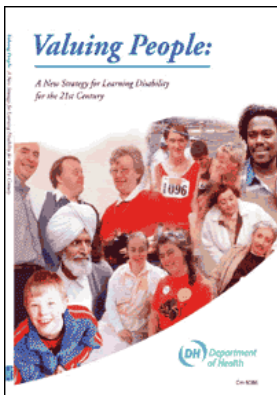
# Valuing People Celebration Event – March 2011

- National co-directors are ending in June



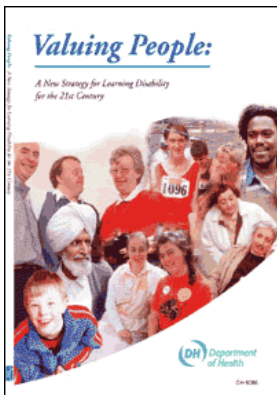
# Valuing People Celebration Event – March 2011

- Regional Forums have a bit of money to keep sending reps to national forum
- Regional Learning Disability Programme Boards are ending in November – regions have plans to handle the change
- Regional Valuing People Teams are ending
- Regional networks are ending



# Valuing People Celebration Event – March 2011

- Partnership Boards are expected to do annual report again this year – in June – and send it to the Public Health Observatory
- The report form will be shorter and there will be an easy read version
- There will be another Big Health Services Check in October – also a shorter form
