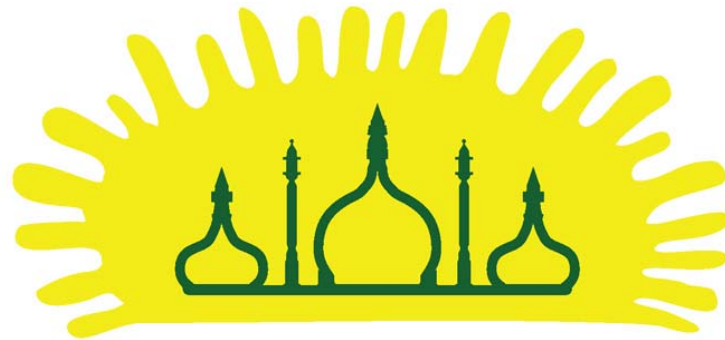
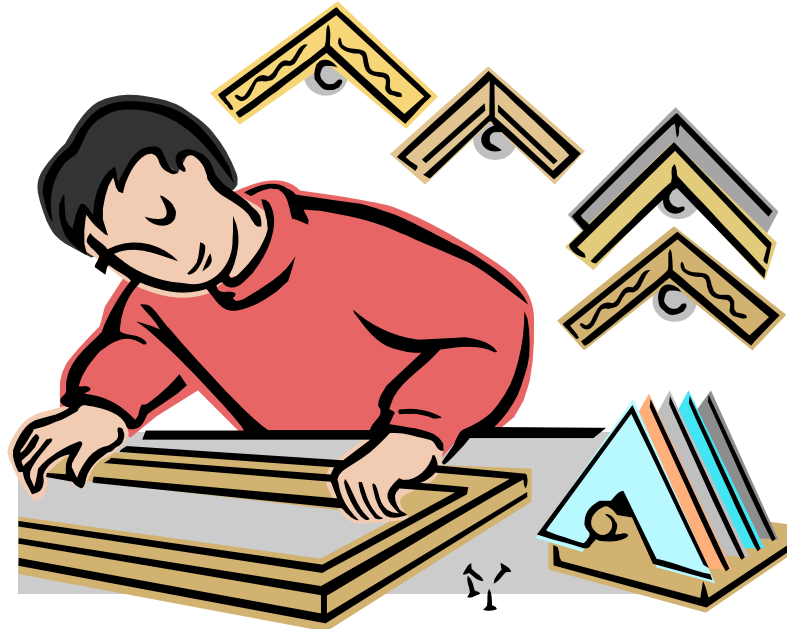


# **Brighton & Hove Work & Skills plan for people with learning disabilities**



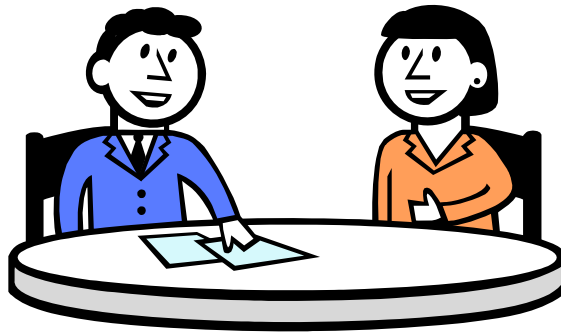

We want all people with learning disabilities, regardless of their disability or situation, who want to work, to have a job, or be self employed, and to have a career.



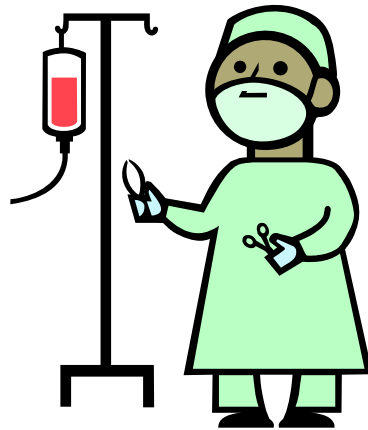
## 5 Big Issues

- Supported Employment Team



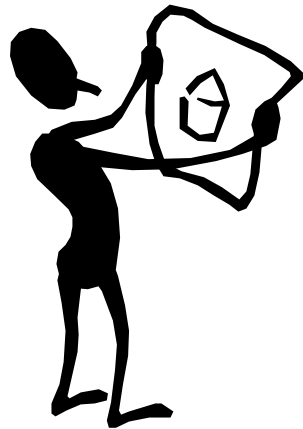
Big changes are happening that will help us with our plan:
