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Joint strategic Needs Assessment

What is it?

- Updates information on need
- Identifies good ways to support people
- Suggests further actions for the future





Joint strategic Needs Assessment

Why is it important?

- We need have good information to make the right decisions
- We need to make sure we 'include everyone'
- We want to continue to improve our information



Joint strategic Needs Assessment

What does it cover?

- Health and Social Care Needs
- Needs of adults - over 18 year olds
- Needs of carers of people with learning disabilities



Joint strategic Needs Assessment

What do we know so far?

- There are 5053 adults 4320 of these 18 -64 years (based on national information)
- We expect this number to increase by
 - 3% over the next 5 years
 - 11.6% by 2030
- With a higher increase in the number of people with severe learning disabilities (15% by 2030)
