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1. How Many People Get a Review

- This is about people who receive social services support and have their needs reviewed by a care manager.
- We want it to be at least 80% per year, which is about 635 reviews each year.
- This is a number we report to the government.
- This information comes from the social services computer database which only counts the people who had reviews this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- Our report shows a beaker and when the beaker is full we have met our target for the year.

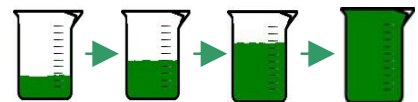


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2. How Many Family Carers Get a Review

- This means we want carers of at least 25% of the people who receive help to live at home to get a review (the number is small because many of the people who are helped to live at home do not live with a family carer).
- This information comes from social services computer database which only counts the people who had reviews this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- We report this number to the government.
- Our report shows when the beaker is full we have met our target.

3. How Many Serious Safeguarding Alerts

- This is about level 3 or 4 alerts – the most serious ones.
- If there was an alert that does not mean there was definitely abuse. The Social Workers investigate each alert to find out what happened.
- We want to know how many there are so we can keep track of them.
- This information comes from social services computer database which only counts the people who had reviews this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- Our report shows the number of these alerts that have happened so far this year.

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4. How Is the Budget Doing

- This is about the budget for learning disability services, which is about £33 million each year.
- We want it to be on budget – not spending too much or too little.
- This information comes from reports that go to the Joint Commissioning Board a few times each year.
- Our report shows faces saying how we think we are going to do this year.

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5. How Many People Are in Paid Work

- This is about people getting social services support who are also doing paid work.
- We have to report this number to the government.
- We want it to be at least 13%, which is about 76 people.
- This information comes from a social services computer database which only counts the people who had reviews this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- Our report shows faces saying how we think we are doing.

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6. How Many People Live In Settled Accommodation

- This means the people living in the home either own the home or have a legal tenancy agreement.
- It is not residential care, prison, hostels or other insecure housing.
- The government want this number to get bigger each year.
- This information comes from a social services database which only counts the people who had a review this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- Our report shows faces saying how we think we are doing.

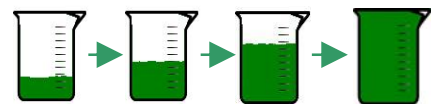


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7. How Many People Live With Family

- This means we also want to know how many of the people living in settled accommodation actually live with their family (or friends).
- This information also comes from a social services database which only counts the people who had a review this year (because that is how the government counts it).
- Our report shows a beaker. If the beaker is half-full then half of them live with family; if the beaker is full then all of them live with family; etc.

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8. How Many Care Homes Are Not So Good

- This is about residential care homes for people with learning disabilities. The homes get checked by the Care Quality Commission and rated excellent, good, adequate or poor.
- We want to know how many are less than good so we can keep track of them and make sure they are being taken care of.
- This information comes from the Care Quality Commission website.
- There are 39 registered care homes in Brighton & Hove and our report shows the number rated poor or adequate.

9. How Many People Can Get Health Checks

- This is about people with learning disabilities being able to get a health check from their doctor..
- It means that their doctor is part of the local enhanced service we have in Brighton & Hove.
- There are more than 800 people with learning disabilities registered with doctors now and we want everyone to be able to get health checks!
- This information comes from the Health Facilitator in the Community Learning Disability Team.
- All but a few people are with doctors who offer the local enhanced service. We want to help those last few get access to health checks too.

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10. How Many People Use Self-directed Support

- There are about 750 people receiving support from social services.
- Last year we wanted at least 150 of them to be using self-directed support.
- We want this number to get bigger each year.
- This information comes from the social services database.
- Our report shows faces saying how many people it is right now.
