

The Link Group's Feedback about Housing



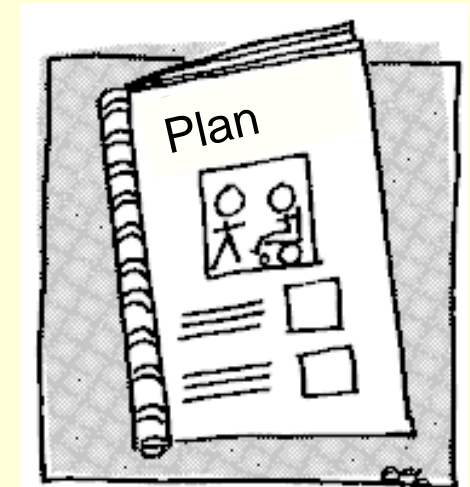
- At the Big Meeting we talked about housing.
- There are 2 main points



- People with mild learning disabilities who do not get much help find it really difficult to get information and support around moving. This can feel upsetting and difficult for them and can make people ill



- We think people should get better support when they want to move. They should know where to go to get help as moving to a new house is really complicated.
- We think the Partnership Board should make a plan to make sure people get help they need.



- Some people who live in registered care homes do not know that they are allowed to move or how to ask to move



- We think that homes, support workers and other staff should talk to people more about their right to move house.
- Many people with learning disabilities need more support to understand they can make choices about what they do in their lives.
