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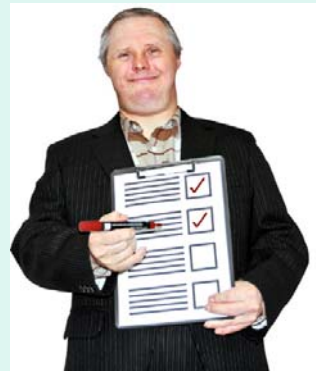

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- We will compare what all Partnership Boards in the South East are doing

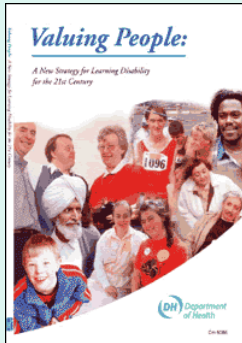


- We have to make sure money and resources are used to make things better in the South East

- We will tell government if it does something that does not properly include people with learning disabilities



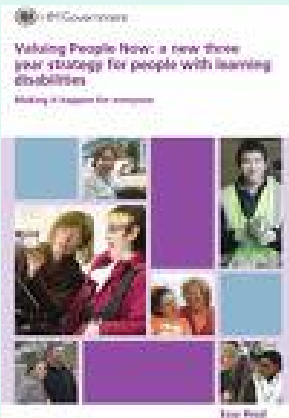
# Regional Plan
