1. How has this made a difference for people with learning disabilities?

- The group have formed new friendships through working together
- The group have improved their teamwork and listening skills
- The group have talked about what good quality support is
- People with learning disabilities are directly involved in developing the 'quality testing tool'
- We have talked about the support service the project workers receive and what areas need improving

2. What have you learnt from the project so far?

- We have found out what support the project workers need
- We have learned technical things to make sure the filming goes well
- We are making sure the toolkit asks questions useful to service users, providers and commissioners
