Please tell us in no more than 75 words what you have done?

This money is being used to support 5 people with challenging behaviour to find housing. The support is from Housing Options (www.housingoptions.org.uk).

So far we have had two meetings to talk about who most needs help to find housing and to start to make plans to support them.

So far we have 6 people that we know need this kind of support and we have made some early plans for 2 of them.

1. How has this made a difference for people with learning disabilities?

It is still early in the project, but these 6 people are all getting housing plans to try to meet their needs.

2. What have you learnt from the project so far?

We have learnt more about what is possible; for example in developing new housing, re-developing housing we already have and working with private landlords.

We also have a better idea of what housing these 6 people need.

3. Is the project going to be complete by the end of March 2012?

It is not likely that people will have moved by then, because that would not be enough time to plan for them to move safely, but we aim to have clear plans for each of them with a likely date for them to move.
