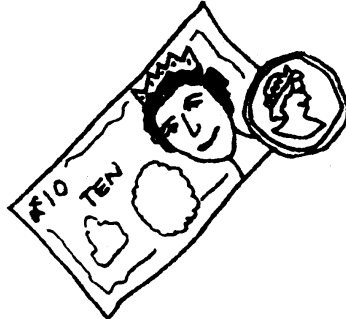


A Transition Information Fair is planned for next year. The feedback from parents will help us plan for this.



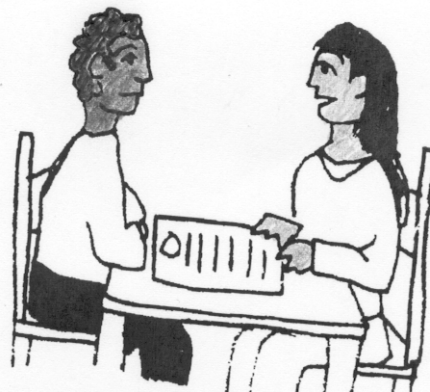
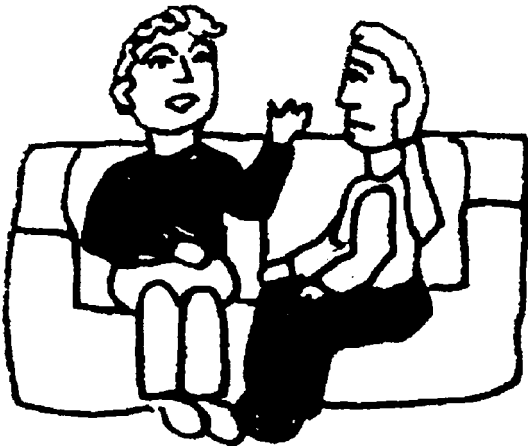
On 5th December there is a session on Money Matters about changes to
