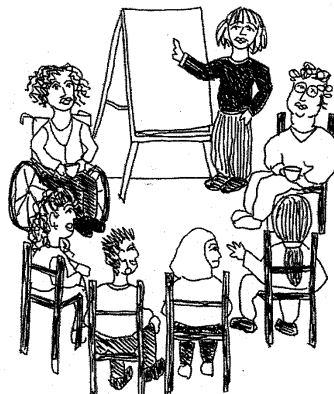

Please tell us in no more than 75 words what you have done?

Worked out a 4 day training programme for volunteers
Trained 18 people – some are parent / carers
12 people are going forward to volunteer
Told staff about the project at the 3 schools we will be working with: Cedar Centre, Downs Park and Patcham House
Told parents about the project in the Amaze newsletter
Designed a leaflet about the project for staff to give parents
Started matching volunteers with families



1. How has this made a difference for people with learning disabilities?

The volunteers are helping parents think about what's important to their young people, to listen to them and how to involve young people in planning for their future



2. What have you learnt from the project so far?

Not everyone we trained was able to go forward to become a volunteer. Some of the parent / carers had too many commitments.

3. Is the project going to be complete by the end of March 2012?

Amaze has committed to finding more funding to continue this project to support parents and their young people.

4. Will the project spend all the money by 2012?

Yes
