We want to continue the work we have started supporting people who live in care homes to speak up.

We welcome bids from groups who must include people with learning disabilities (who must get paid for their time) to do the following:

- Work with resident groups from 4 nominated care homes.
- Support the development of the resident groups by attending 4 residents meetings in each care home (16 in total) and working alongside the residents to support them to make the changes they want. These meetings may be in the evenings.
- After the 4 resident meetings have been held write a report about what you did and what has changed for the people who live in the care homes and any things you think have been learnt about supporting people in care homes to speak up and what the Partnership Board should do to support people to speak up and make changes in their lives.
- You will present your report to the Person Centred Approaches Sub Group at the end of the project.
