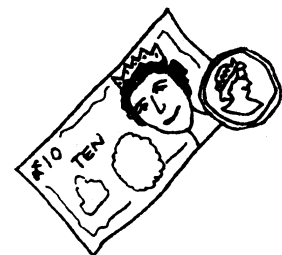
How much LDDF money does your project want in 2009-2010?

People will be helped to change to different kinds of services if they want to. The services will get be better at talking to each other.

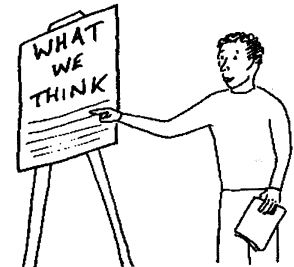


People will be helped to use mainstream services.

What outcomes, targets or goals would your project achieve?

- help the network talk to the people who control the money
- we will give reports every three months

- service users will help us decide if the project is working well
