<p>Which Partnership Board Sub Group is leading this area of work? Taking Part in the City</p>
<p>How much LDDF money does your project want in 2010-2011? Asked for £10,000 but were given £5,000</p>
<p>What is the budget (how will you spend the money) for the project and is any other money also going to be used for this project?</p> <p>We are asking Brighton Learning Disability Fund for £10,000; We will use £4,000 to pay for a years rent for the space we would need to rent to carry out the project. This is based on £40 per day for 2 days a week for a year. We would use the other £6000 to pay for 1:1 support _ - 400 hours @ £15 per hour. We have applied for £14,000 from The Media Trusts Community Voices Fund. which would pay for a part time Project co-ordinator to oversee the project as well as some extra equipment. This would be sufficient to get the project up and running.</p> <p>We are prepared to apply for a lottery Awards for All grant later in the project. A local design company are sponsoring our media project by donating:</p> <p>2 x Apple Mac Laptops, 1 x ink jet printer, 1 x digital SLR camera.</p>
<p>Tell us about the Project, how it will work, what it will do, who will do it and things like that:</p> <p>A group of our participants and volunteers have all been working together on a plan to develop Spiral Community radio and internet Magazine.</p>

This involves initially using our website to promote podcasts and then to continue working alongside Brighton Free Radio, BBC Southern Counties Radio and Heart FM to access air time for regular broadcasts.

We aim to create a bi-monthly magazine, and a Spiral radio show that can be accessed as a podcast via our web-site.

What outcomes, targets or goals would your project achieve?

Our weekly timetable will be centred on creating the magazine and the radio programmes. All members who sign up for the project will be involved at some stage in the planning, collating, recording, editing and uploading of the radio programmes. The shows may contain: comedy sketches, songs, What's on section, adverts, jingles, Brighton Live - interviewing, volunteer appeals and volunteer of the week.

Those who wish to get involved with the magazine will be allocated and supported in duties that work towards the current planning, writing, creating content, design and layout, proof reading, production and Up-loading onto the web-site.

We wish to address:

1. Lack of opportunities to develop performing skills.
2. Lack of opportunities to be heard and understood.
3. Lack of access to almost any form of media let alone digital.
4. Lack of opportunity to undertake meaningful work training and experience.

We hope that through our media project:

People will have a better job and learning satisfaction.

Peoples feeling of self worth and pride will be increased

People will have better quality job skills that may lead to proper employment.

We will increase the understanding across the wider community of the needs and abilities of our participants.

We will be better able to inform and access other members of our community who are isolated.
